Annual Enrollment Coming to an End

The period for Annual Enrollment is October 15 to December 7. While there is still plenty of time to do what you need to do, you have but 30 days remaining.

To review, AEP for those with Medicare Supplements, is a time to review your prescription drug coverage for 2023 to see if your 2022 plan coverage is still the least costly plan available. **Please** do not assume that because you take one or just a few prescription drug plans that you do not need to check... these plans can change **DRAMATICALLY** each year.

I believe that the providers take advantage of the fact that more than 70% of the folks with drug plans do not check their plans for the coming year. As a result, significant price increases sneak by only to be discovered when it is too late to change. **Do not let that happen to you!**

I realize that the Medicare.gov plan finder can be confusing so I have tried, through various means, to let each of you know that I am more than willing to be your resource to get this done. You are my clients. I am happy to do what I can to help with this. In most cases, I will be unable to assist you with the enrollment as there are just too many plans for me to be certified with each plan. But (!) I am a whiz at Medicare.gov and I can identify the three best plans for your consideration – I just need a list of your drugs to do this. Then all you have to do is call the 800 number I provide and enroll. Doing so will cancel your current plan. If we haven't done this, text me your drugs at 925-519-1867.
